





AUTONOMOUS EMERGENCY BRAKING ASSESSMENT



ASEAN NCAP is introducing the Autonomous Emergency Braking (AEB) system functionality assessment in its new 2021-2025 protocol. In the protocol, ASEAN NCAP assessed the functionality and effectiveness of AEB City (car-to-car rear stationary) and AEB Inter-Urban (car-to-car rear moving) systems fitted inside the vehicle in performing emergency braking at several speeds against another preceeding vehicle. The new Nissan Almera offers both the AEB City and Inter-Urban systems as standard or optional across all its variants. In this assessment, ASEAN NCAP confirms the technologies have functioned according to the ASEAN NCAP requirements.

BLIND SPOT DETECTION ASSESSMENT



Starting from the 2017-2020 protocol, ASEAN NCAP introduced an assessment on the functionality of Blind Spot Technology fitted inside the assessed vehicle. ASEAN NCAP continues the assessment under the new Motorcyclist Safety pillar for the new 2021-2025 protocol. The new Nissan Almera is equipped with Blind Spot Detection (BSD) on both sides of the vehicle either as standard or optional across all its variants. In the assessment, ASEAN NCAP confirms the technology has functioned according to the ASEAN NCAP requirements on both sides of the vehicle.



OVERALL RATING

This is the second assessment that ASEAN NCAP conducted for the Nissan Almera model in which it was first tested in 2013. Under the earlier protocol (2012-2016), the sedan obtained a 4-Star rating for the Adult Occupant Protection (AOP) and a 52% compliance for its Child Occupant Protection (COP) category. For this year's model the new Almera offers a standard fitment of 6 airbags with Electronic Stability Control (ESC), Anti-lock Braking System (ABS), Seatbelt Reminder System (SBR) for driver only in all its variants. Additionally, the Almera is also equipped with safety technologies namely Autonomous Emergency Braking (AEB) City, AEB Inter-Urban, Forward Collision Warning (FCW), Lane Departure Warning (LDW), Blind Spot Detection (BSD), Automatic High Beam (AHB) are available either as standard or optional equipment across all variants. The new Nissan Almera performed well under the current 2021-2025 ASEAN NCAP assessment protocol by obtaining an overall score of 74.74 points. Nissan's latest sedan achieved the maximum rating of 5 stars for AOP and COP. The model achieved the maximum rating of 4 stars for the Safety Assist (SA) and Motorcyclist Safety (MS) categories. These achieved scores have made the new Almera eligible to be awarded with 4-Star ASEAN NCAP rating.
