### **ECONOMY**

- Economic growth in 2022 reaches 8.02% over the same period last year (the highest rate in the period 2011-2022) and 5% in 2023.
- Successful in poverty
   alleviation (Percentage of
   households with income of
   under national poverty line
   2005/2023 = 22% / 5.7%)
- GDP: 4.800 USD per capita (est. 2025)
- GDP PPP: 17.500 USD per capital (Est. 2025)



# DEMOGRAPHY AND SOCIETY

- Population: 100.3 millions (National Population and Housing Survey, 2023)
- Relative young population (94,2% of population <</li>
   65 years old)
- Fast and high risk of uncontrolled urbanization of illegal migration [Urban population 19% (1986) ->25% (2002) ->45% (2025)].



## ROAD REGISTERED MOTORIZED VEHICLES (2023)

- Automobile: 6.3 Million
- Motorcycles & Moped: 74Million



# Road safety management

Regulations: law, degree, circular, standard, guideline:
Ministry of public security
Ministry of construction,
Ministry of public security,
Ministry of Health

Enforcement: Ministry of public security (Traffic Police)
Local Government

Road design and investment, maintain, traffic organization:
Ministry of
Construction

(Local Department of construction & Local government)

# Restructure of transport sector: Reduction of road transport dependency

- Increasing the market share of Inland Waterway and coastal transport for medium and long distance freight transport
- Increasing the market share of aviation and railway for medium and long distance passenger transport
- Strengthening capacity and quality of public transport service
- Subsidizing for urban public transport users in Ha Noi, Ho Chi Minh City, Da Nang..









## Safer Infrastructure

## Decree 13-NQ/TW dated on 16 January 2012 of VCP Central Committee

- Improving safety conditions of the roads (Widen and Instalation of physical center separation; provide reflexible traffic sign, signals and markings)
- Contruction of new expressways, passing roads and ring roads to separate long distance and through traffic from the local traffic
- Comprehenvie upgrading international airports at Hanoi, HCM City, Da Nang, Can Tho, Cam Ranh and other regional airport
- Upgrading the key national inland water ways in Mekong River Delta and Red River Delta; Improving capacity of river ports and habours.
- Improvement of the maritime ports; comprehensive development two major dept water port and Lach Huyen and Cai Mep, Thi Vai.
- Sustainable traffic infrastructure maintenance funds (road, railway, inlandwaterway, airport & aitraffic control, maritime channels and facilities) E.g.: Annual national highway maitenance fund is about US\$ 400.000-60.000 millions / 80% comes from road maintenance fee of road vehicles.



# **ROAD SAFETY EDUCATION and TRAINING**

- Improving the education materials and teaching approach for school children and teaching guidlines for teacher
- Organizing big event for road safety campaigning
- Automatic testing for driver examination (knowledges and driving skills)
- National and Provincial TVs, Radios, newspapers must proviode road safety programs or collumn


90% adults

# **Motorcycle safety** – education and training

VAMM – MOET - NTSC Since 2014: VAMM training to 13 million leaners, including 8 secondary school students, 2 million primary school students, 300000 high school students.

National Competition for primary, secondary and high school students, and teachers.

2019-2023: Honda motorcycle driving skill education and training: 17 million/year.

Traffic Policemen deliver safety education at primary, secondary and high school nationwide





## ACTIONS FOR THE NEXT DECADE

Directive 23-CT/TW dated on 25th May 2023 of VCP Secretary Committee Resolution 48/NQ-CP dated on 5 April 2022

- 1. Strengethening of leaderships and traffic safety management capacity.
- 2. Improving law formulation and enforcement; Integrated traffic safety objectives in the social and physical development plans (national, provincial and city levels)
- 3. Improvement of capacity, quality and safety of the transport infrastructure
- 4. Improvement of vehicle safety, quality and sustainability
- 5. Restructuring transport markets (increasing freight transport market share of maritime, inland waterway and railway; increasing passenger transport market share of public transport) to reduce road dependency of transport.
- 6. Building traffic safety culture within organizations, private sectors, citizens
- 7. Deployment of IT and smart traffic management technologies; development of integrated traffic safety database systems between transport authority, traffic police, public health and insurance.
- 8. Improvement of emergency services; Post crash evacuation and pre-hospital treatment; in-hospital treatment;

## **NEW ROAD SAFETY LEGISLATIONS**

### **ROAD LAW 2024**

- Focusing on physical infrastructure and transport services.
- Standardizing of ITS systems (intercity; urban roads; road management centre).
- Standardizing and Regulating Road database systems (road network plan and investment database; roadways and facilities databases; Road Tolling database; Commercial transport database)
- Standardising & regulating village roads and urban alleys.
- Regulating road connection for intermodal transport (road connection for airport, sea & river port, railway station);
- A comprehensive chapter for expressway
- Comprehensive regulations on transport services (commercial transport service; internal transport services; rescue and emergency transport service; school bus service)
- Decentralization of state management power and responsibility in road sector.

### **ROAD TRAFFIC ORDER AND SAFETY LAW 2024**

- Focusing on dynamic traffic entities: driver behaviours;
   vehicles; traffic monitoring, control and enforcement
- Standing agency for road safety: Ministry of Public Security
- Standardizing and Regulating Traffic Safety Database
   Systems (vehicles registry and ownership; vehicle
   inspection; drivers; traffic violation; accident; commercial
   GPS & camera monitoring database; commercial driver
   working time database)
- Improving road safety for children: Child Restraint System;
  Road Safety Training Certificate for E-bike and small
  moped drivers; Obligation of road safety education
  program and contents in national school system (from
  Kinder Garten to High School)
- Lowering speed limit in the high density urban areas (authorized power to local government);
- Strengthening Zero Tolerance Alcohol policy.
